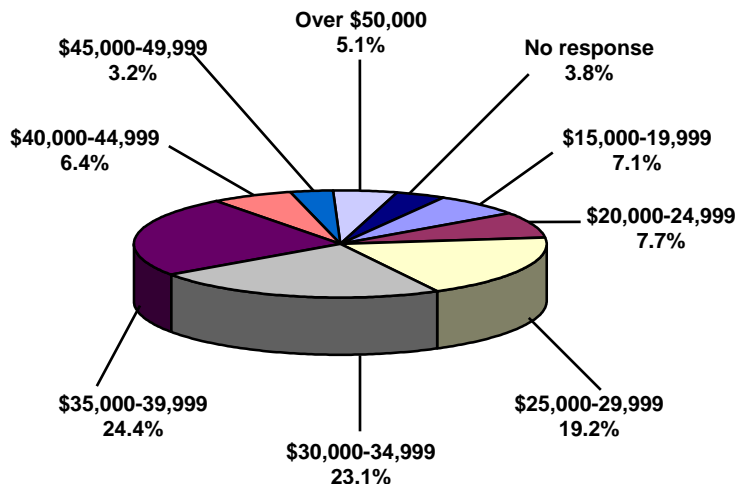
The 156 respondents* were engaged in the following activities:

Beginning salary ranges for graduates employed in their major or related business field:

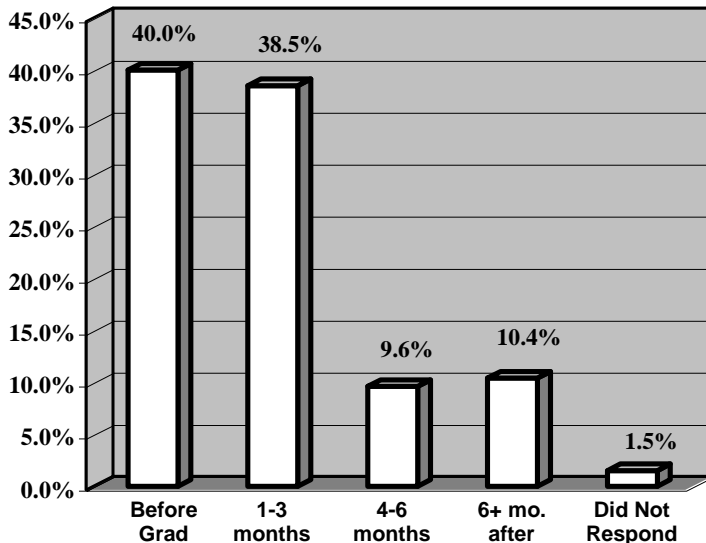


Our Goal Is Your Success

How quickly did they find work?

Approximately 88 percent of the persons working full-time in their major or in a related business field were employed within six months of graduation.

How important were the following factors in securing employment?

Work experience of any type	57.1%	92.9%
Internship/work experience in major*	55.1%	83.3%
Coursework in major	42.3%	88.5%
Leadership activities	29.5%	71.8%
Business administration core courses	19.2%	71.8%
University extra-curricular activities	14.1%	51.3%
Grade point average	10.9%	64.1%

*Fifty-nine percent of respondents completed an internship while attending S.U.
